



NO SMOKING POLICY

On July 1st 2007, England introduced a new law to make virtually all enclosed public places and workplaces in England smoke free.

- No persons will be allowed to smoke or use electronic cigarettes in the setting, including the outside area.
- No adult accompanying children on an outing from the pre-school will smoke.
- All areas of the setting will be checked daily, especially the outside play area for any remains of cigarettes or lighters/matches etc, which may have been left by other users of the premises.
- In cases where there is smoke at a harmful level outdoors, the children will be brought inside until it has cleared.
- No smoking signs will be displayed around the room at all times.
